- The Multi-use Games Area (MUGA) at Fore Street park has been closed.
- We are also required to close the skate park and outdoor gym at Millstream Meadow. Unlike the MUGA, we do not have the means to prevent access to these facilities. Instead, we need to rely on the community spirit and good sense of those who normally use these facilities. Please help us by not using the skate park and outdoor gym until the new restrictions are lifted.
- I have one bit of good news, the play parks around the town are able to remain open. That said, children are meant to only play by themselves or with other members of their household. Physical distancing of two metres should be maintained. If you visit one of the play parks and think it is too crowded to achieve physical distancing then I would advise that you come back later.

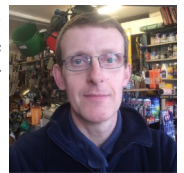
